Position responsibilities encompassed all computer related technology within the agency. Overseeing the hosting of the agency web portal, working on internet and windows application development, analysis and design of software, assisting in hardware and

Based upon internal staff requirements programmed a client tracking and billing system using MS Visual Studio 2008 in C# with MS SQL Server as the database backend. Designed and developed the website for the agency using code modules which functioned within a UI framework. The modules and framework were developed in a combination of VB.Net and C#. For the independent agents associated with the agency a suite of tools and reports were developed; these included a lead tracking system, to assist both the agents and internal management in tracking the assignment and status of developed sales leads, and an automated commission reporting system in C# which converted uploaded insurance provider spreadsheets and produced secured PDF files for the agents to view or download. The development tools most used for this position included MS Visual Studio 2003, 2005 & 2008, C#, VB.Net, MS SQL Server 2000 & 2005, Ajax Control Toolbox, JavaScript, CSS, and some Classic ASP.

A system that allowed a major fast food chain to monitor electrical usage and control HVAC, lighting and security systems of 1500 company owned restaurants through an internet interface. The system was written in Visual Basic 6 and made use of 3<sup>rd</sup> party smart circuit libraries to pass data to a SQL Server database. The data was compiled and compared to produce exception reports displayed using ASP. Commands can be sent to the circuits in the restaurants to allow remote control of the lighting, electrical appliances, HVAC and temperature settings, and the security system.

Another Application is the Athlete Zone website, developed for use by a local television station in its "Commit to be Fit" fitness campaign. Performed the application design and acted as the Lead Developer. The site was built using a template format developed with ASP.Net and with functionality coded into separate modules utilizing a combination of VB.Net and C# to allow for expansion and modification in the future. Tools used include MS Project, MS Visio, VB.Net, C#, ASP.Net, MS SQL Server with stored procedures, and 3<sup>rd</sup> party controls for dynamic PDF creation and graphical chart display.
